2. Abstract Instructions and Example

Please follow these instructions for preparation of one page of abstract.

1. Language  
English

2. Abstract format (Refer to example below)

- Title of Presentation (Bold 12 pt Times New Roman)
- Author name, affiliation and body of abstract should follow the title without bold type and with a 12 pt Times New Roman font
- Your abstract should be single spaced.
- Use left justification with a 3.0 cm, top margin and 2.5 cm margins for the bottom and both sides
- Length of the summary should not exceed one page
- Put your picture on the top left

1. Language

English only

2. Size

We recommend you prepare an A0 size poster (90 cm wide × 110 cm tall).

3. Format

Format of the poster is basically free. However, please include your presentation title, name(s) of presenter(s) and affiliation(s). You can include a photograph of yourself if you would like. (Font size should be large enough to be read from 2 m)

4. Display

Posters should be hung in the designated at 1<sup>st</sup> Floor , Vajiranusorn Building, Faculty of Agriculture, Kasetsart University on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2016, Please hang your poster as soon as possible so participants of the symposium will have more opportunities to view your poster. Each poster will be assigned a number and a list of the numbers for the posters will be displayed in the poster room. Please confirm the number of your poster on the list and hang your poster under the designated number. Supplies needed to hang posters will be available in the poster room.

You are expected to be present during the entire poster session on Thursday February 25<sup>th</sup> from 9.30 am to 11.30 am to explain and answer questions about your poster.

5. Removal

Please remove your poster on Friday February 25<sup>th</sup> from before 3:00 pm. If a poster is not removed by that time it will be taken down and kept at International Affairs Division, 7<sup>th</sup> Floor Vajiranusorn Building, Faculty of Agriculture, Kasetsart University.

6. Best Poster Award

Each poster presentation will be evaluated by Professor of University of Tsukuba & Faculty members of Faculty of Agriculture, Kasetsart University and during

the poster session on Thursday February 25<sup>th</sup> from 9.30 am to 11.30 am. Best Presentation Award(s) will be presented based on the evaluation.
